So, when some of my dear friends had their first child, I surprised them with a handmade banner with his name on it. They loved it, so of course I made another one when they recently had their second baby.These banners make great gifts and can be used for years to come. Read the instructions below to see how I did it, or watch the video:) What you need: à Woven fabric for flags in one or more colours. The amount depends on how long the name you will wear, but in general 1.5 meters of fabric should be enough. - Woven fabric for contrasting colour letters. You just need some. - Bias tape. I used five yards. - Interface Fuses à Fuse Fuses à Matching Wire à Sewing Machine à IronI started by cutting out the pieces of the flags, using the design I drew when they had their first child. Use any shape you like, just make sure to add seam allowance all around. Each flag needs two pieces, so I will cut twice as many flags as I want to get, dividing them evenly between the colors of the fabric.Later, I printed the letters with the child’s name. I chose a simple font, so that the cutting and sewing will be easier. I ripped out the letters and got a fuse strap. This is similar to the fuse interface, as you can iron on the fabric. However, the fuse weave uses paper instead of the fabric, which can be detached later. It is basically a two-sided fabric tape.I traced the letters on the paper side of the fuse strap, making sure to do it backwards! Then I roughly cut around the letters and ironed them on the fabric for the letters. After letting it cool a bit, I was able to cut the letters out of the fabric.I ironed an interface fuse on the back of the pieces that will receive the letters. This strengthens the fabric and prevents it from grouping up when you sew the letters on it.I peeled the paper holder and ironed the letters on the flags. Then I stitched a tight stitch zigzag all the way around the letters to secure them permanently.Now that all the preparation has been done, I could start sewing the flags. I put together two flags of the same color right sides and sewed around the sides. I then cut the seam allowance with pink shears to keep the fabric from tearing. Around the point, I cut off as much fabric as I could.I turned all the flags right out and I ironed them flat. Then, I cut out all the floors a little bit, so that both layers were the same length.I used Bias tape for the line. I simply placed each flag between the folded ribbon, using clips to hold them in place. Then I sewed the whole bias tape, closing it and permanently attaching the flags.And that’s it. A sum of 2,487,983 Richards amounts to 1.43 percent of all children born between 1918 and 2017. The 1,106,071 Susans represents 0.65% of the total births of the child. As for Millers, 1,161,437 was recorded in 2010. Another Hispanic surname comes to number six. There were 1,116,120 Garcias in the 2010 census. But in the course of the last century, there were more than 3,557,293 David and more than 1,410,059 Barbara. The 3,393,456 females named Mary aCCounted for 2 2 of all the girl’s births. The name can be confused with some, since the prefix “pent-” refers to five, and there are 10 oxygen atoms in the compound. Phosphorus pentoxide gets its name from the empirical formula of the compound, which is P2O5. The molecules of P2O5 are unstable and associate with each other to form the larger molecules of P4O10. Physical properties of P4O10 At room temperature, phosphorus pentoxide is a solid white waxed substance and is typically a powder. The molecule has a hexagonal shape and is held together with weak van der Waals forces. This compound is unique as it exists in four different polymorphs. The most common is two P2O5 molecules joined together to form the largest P4O10. All polymorphs of phosphorus pentoxide are based around the tetrahedral arrangement of phosphorus and oxygen atoms make up the compound. It dissolves at 340C and bubbles at 360C. Since the melting point and boiling points are so close together, phosphorus pentoxide often skips melting and sublime from solid to gas. Chemical properties of P4O10 Phosphorus pentoxide is a polar compound. It is a non-combustible compound, which means it does not react with oxygen to produce a flame. However, it is highly reactive with water and forms phosphoric acid when combined with water. It can cause a fire if it comes into contact with water-containing materials, such as cotton or wood. When exposed to metal, it causes corrosion and forms various metal oxides. It is also corrosive to skin and other tissues, leading to chemical burns and respiratory inflammation. These irritations and lesions also occur in small concentrations. Adequate safety measures are required when handling phosphorus pentoxide. The production of P4O10 Phosphorus pentoxide is typically produced through the combustion of phosphorus and oxygen. The burning tetraphosphorus with a large amount of oxygen produces the compound. White phosphorus is needed as a starting material. Although adding water to phosphorus pentoxide produces phosphoric acid, the reaction does not work the other way round. It is not possible to produce phosphorus pentoxide by dehydrating phosphoric acid. Uses for P4O10 Phosphorus pentoxide is commonly used in the production of phosphoric acid. Because it reacts so easily with water, it is also used as a desiccant and dehydration agent. Draw moisture out of the air to keep a moisture-free zone. Phosphorus pentoxide has a tendency to form a protective layer around the outside during storage, which prevents pulling into any more moisture. Because of this, it is often used in its granular form for drying. As an industrial desiccant, this compound plays an intermediate role in the transformation of acids into their anhydride counterparts. For example, it is used to convert nitric acid (HNO3) to nitrogen dioxide (N2O5). Phosphorus pentoxide is also used in the manufacture of glass, rubber and some laboratory procedures.
